



Rules of Volleyball for Pirongia Module

Team Composition

Each team is to supply a Captain / Spokesperson and a list of team members, to the Pirongia Volleyball Module Management committee.

A maximum of 6 players are allowed on the court at any one time. A minimum of 4 players is required for a match to begin.

The team must not have more than 3 male players on the court at once. The game will be forfeited if this is not adhered to. (Primary school boys are classed as a female player.)

The Referee

Each team referees themselves as the game is played.

Scoring

A point is scored only whilst the team maintains service. The team with the most points wins (not the first to 21). Each team scores themselves as the game is played.

Substitution

Teams may interchange only during serve changeover..

Possession of the ball

Handover occurs:

- The ball goes to ground
- The ball goes out of court (on the line is out!)
- More than three whacks have been executed
- The ball touches the net on service
- A player touches the net whilst playing the ball
- The ball is smashed on the immediate return of the ball (ball must be pushed or set)

Duration and start times

The match at Pirongia Volleyball shall be 14 minutes each way with a turn around at half time. The game start times will be 6.15pm, 6.50pm and 7.25pm. A hooter will start and end each half.

Results

Each team is to fill in their result on the "results board" in the clubrooms. Failure to do this will result in no points being awarded to that team.

Note: Play continues if ball comes in contact with the Oak tree and remains in.
